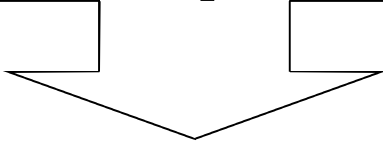




Individual Healthcare Plan (IHP)
